From the Pastor's Desk

The Solemnity of Pentecost has traditionally been described as the birth of the Church. In Acts, Luke gives a dramatic account of the Holy Spirit descending on the followers of Jesus and of multitudes who were baptized as a result of Peter's preaching. The First Reading for today is an excerpt from this story. Luke writes that pilgrims from all parts of the world have filled Jerusalem because of the Jewish feast of Pentecost. At this time the first fruits of the harvest were offered in the Temple. It also was (and is) a celebration of the giving of the Torah on Mount Sinai. Both stories remind us that we are God's holy people, enlivened by the Holy Spirit.

Today's Second Reading also testifies to the power of the Holy Spirit. Paul reminds the reader that the Spirit is manifest in a variety of gifts, given not for personal gain, but for the common good. There is one Spirit, Paul says, who unites the community of believers, just as a body unites its parts, and just as all disciples are united as one Body of Christ.

In John's Gospel, the evangelist provides yet another account of the giving of the Holy Spirit. Jesus' first words to the disciples are "Peace be with you," recalling the farewell discourse when he told them that the Father would send the Holy Spirit to console them and teach them when he was gone. Now, as he returns, he sends them out on mission and breathes on them, recalling how God breathed on a lump of clay (Adam) and brought the first human to life. The disciples, too are called to new life in the Spirit.
